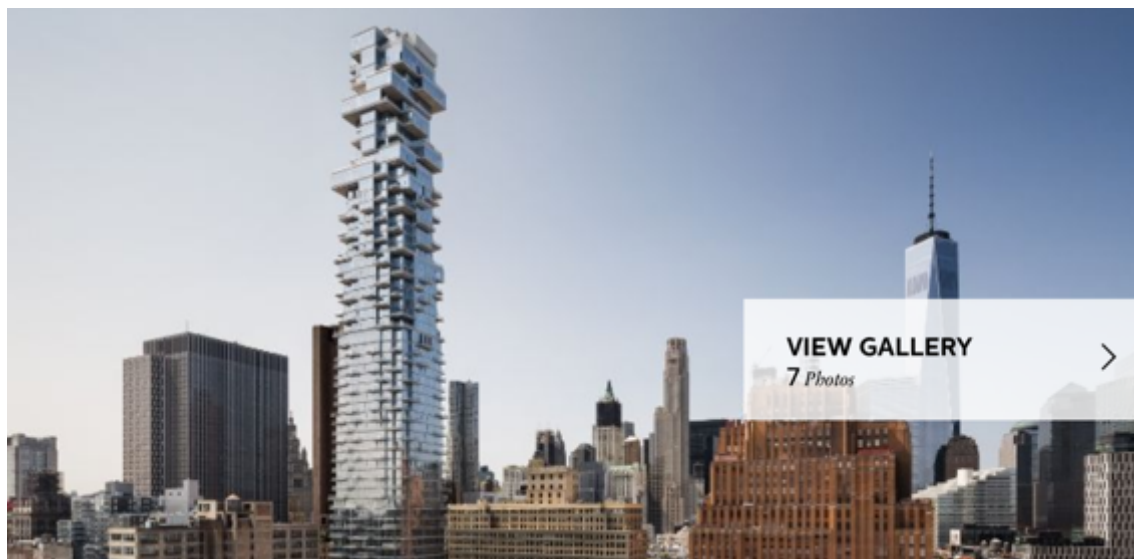


PEEK INSIDE HERZOG & DE MEURON'S 56 LEONARD, NEW YORK CITY'S 'JENGA TOWER'

If you're a [New Yorker](#), or have visited the city in the last several years, you've probably noticed a new addition to the [Manhattan skyline](#): 56 Leonard Street, known more affectionately known as the 'Jenga Tower'.

Herzog & de Meuron, the Swiss architecture firm behind the illusive [skyscraper](#), finally released images of the building's stellar interiors. Let's just say, they're as dramatic as the building's facade, with amenities like a library lounge, an indoor-outdoor movie theater, and a private dining salon. Take a peek inside.



The skyscraper's shared spaces feature brutalist interiors with modern lighting and furniture throughout.
